LOTTERY RULES

1. All entrants to the competition will be deemed to have accepted these rules and regulations.
2. Applications must be by players aged 18 years or over using the application form supplied by Eckington Village Memorial Hall (EVMH) committee.
3. Payment for entry to the lottery is £4 per entry each month via standing order on 1st of each month. Players may have more than one entry.
4. On receipt of a completed application form and standing order for payment players will be issued with a registration card with their unique number for each entry into the monthly draws.
5. If a payment is not made on 1st of the month the allocated number will be removed from the draws for that month. To be eligible for the December Bonus Draw players must have 9 months minimum continuous participation.
6. The winning numbers will be drawn on the first Tuesday of each month (with the exception should the first Tuesday fall on the 1st of the month), using a random number generator. The winning numbers will be posted on the EVMH external noticeboard and Eckington Village Noticeboard Facebook page.
7. The winners will be notified via the contact details provided on their application form. Prizes will be paid into the winners' bank account using the details provided for the standing order set up. The promoter will endeavour to distribute prizes within 14 calendar days of the winner being notified. No interest will be payable.
8. No alternative to the prize will be offered and no correspondence will be entered into. The Promoter's decision is final.
9. The Promoter may (without giving any reason or notice) decline to accept an application, or cancel an existing subscription.
10. The promoter is not responsible for any delay in banking system payments.
11. There will be 4 prizes every month with an extra bonus prize in December. Any players found to be under the minimum age stated above will automatically forfeit the right to any prize.
12. The lottery shall cease as a result of any of the following;
 - a) The number of active players drops below 100
 - b) The Promoter giving not less than 2 month's notice of termination of the lottery
 - c) The closure of EVMH.
14. The Promoter has the right to update the rules at their discretion.

This lottery is organised by EVMH Committee and is registered with Wychavon District Council as a small lottery under the Gambling Act 2005.
